

## New Article: Canceling Your Firm's Retreat? Think Twice.

We're excited to share groundbreaking research recently published by Heidi K. Gardner, Madeline K. Kneeland (Babson University), and Adam M. Kleinbaum (Dartmouth) that highlights the powerful impact of strategic firm offsites on smarter collaboration and revenue growth. The study, based on eight years of data from over 750 partners at a global professional firm, reveals that offsites lead to a remarkable 24% increase in collaboration and over \$180,000 in new revenue within the first two months.
